 - Dynamic UNIT and Thermo 1.1
- Identify extensions/implementations needed by users
 - ⇒ e.g. Petroleum Fractions / Solids
- Straighten up the website contents

 - Need of some modification after 1.0 IDL revamping
 - ⇒ UNIT: to make it 1.0 compliant
 - ⇒ MINLP: same needs as for PPDB
- ♦ CO data logger : 25 K€
 - ⇒ Contract development



Mission 5, Training Facilitation, 5 K€

Support to training services and promotion: 5 K€



Administration, 42 K€

◆ CTO salary: 30 K€

Provision for various administrative costs: 2 K€

⊃ Taxes: 400 €

⇒ Bank charges: 150 €
