#### Introduction

- Management Board has identified requirement for certification of CAPE-OPEN implementations
  - Improve the reliability of CAPE-OPEN interoperability
  - Add assurance for end-users
    - Avoiding the need for extensive interoperability testing
- A new Certification SIG will be created
- □ An initial Certification project will establish the charter and other requirements for the new SIG
  - Led by Malcolm Woodman (MR Woodman Consultants)



#### **Steering Groups**

#### Business SG

- Management of project to deliver initial prototype
