# **Interoperability SIG Annual Report: Charter**

Task:

To provide tools and advice to support the achievement of CAPE-OPEN interoperability and to carry out interoperability testing where appropriate.

**Key Responsibilities:** 

- Provide new tools, as required, to support the achievement of CAPE-OPEN interoperability by PMC and PME developers
- Develop and maintain the existing CO-LaN portfolio of software tools
- Use the suite of vendor-licensed software available to CO-LaN to assist in interoperability testing



# **Interoperability SIG Annual Report: Deliverables**

#### **CAPE-OPEN Logging & Testing Tool (COLTT)**

- Allows logging of interaction between PME and PMC
- Maintenance
- Developments to maintain consistency with published standards
- Applicable to multiple versions, has own versioning scheme
- Currently v2.4, released 2016
- TLB/PIA Installer
  - Standardised installation of TLB & PIA, to ensure compatibility between PMEs and PMCs from different vendors
  - Maintenance
  - Developments to maintain consistency with published standards

- Versioning consistent with CAPE-OPEN standard version
- Currently v1.1.0

#### Work process

- Monthly conference calls to survey progress and identify actions
- Regular joint meetings with M&T SIG, covering issues that overlap the 2 SIGs
- SIG oversees the work by the new CO-LaN Software Development Resource



### **Software Development Resource**

- MRW has led the activity to identify a new Software Development resource capable of working across the CO-LaN
- **Scope:** 
  - CAPE-OPEN Logging and Testing Tool (COLTT) and associated installer
  - Type library, Primary Interop Assembly (PIA) and associated installer
  - Certification self-test suite Software and installers
  - Note: COBIA middleware is explicitly excluded at this time
- □ 3 responses received to RfB (Request for Bids)
  - Following discussions with interested parties, CO-LaN have finalised a 3-way agreement with:
    - Marcus Bruno, Brazil
    - Loïc d'Anterroches, Céondo
    - Jasper van Baten, AmsterCHEM
  - Master contracts signed
  - Actual work and cost of individual projects controlled by "Contractor Work Authorisation Form" (CWAF)



## Activities 2019-2020: Versioning

- □ Full versioning proposal has been developed jointly with M&T SIG
- Proposal defines:
  - Breaking change
  - Feature addition (extensions)
  - Bug fixes, patches, errata and clarifications
- Version numbering system
  - Major.minor.patch.(revision or build)
  - Major
    - Breaking change with significant compatibility issues
  - Minor
    - Breaking change, but with limited impact
    - All features of version with same *major* number but lower *minor* number are still supported

- Patch
  - Feature addition
- Revision or Build
  - Patch or bug fix



### Activities 2019-2020: COLTT

#### □ New release version (v2.5) due for release imminently

- Licence text and copyright notices updated
  - Following recent Management Board approval of new licensing schemes for all CO-LaN products
- Addition of support for:
  - Energy & Information streams
  - Flowsheet monitoring
- Upgrade to VS2019 Community Edition
- The potential to use COLTT to track reference counting is to be investigated
  - At a minimum, any reference counting issues introduced by COLTT will be removed



## Activities 2019-2020: TLB/PIA Installer

#### □ New release version (v1.1.1) due for release imminently

- Licence text and copyright notices updated
  - Following recent Management Board approval of new licensing schemes for all CO-LaN products
  - Addresses concerns of vendors over re-distribution rights
- Addition of
  - Flowsheet monitoring
  - Custom Data
- Resolution of issues with simultaneous install of both 64-bit and 32-bit merge modules
